Welcome to 2023! Hopefully, everyone has recovered from the holidays and is looking forward to a healthy, happy, prosperous and exciting new year! Our District has some exciting additions that have either arrived or will be arriving here shortly to improve experiences for our patrons.

We have a new digital monument reader board (6'3 ft. x 7 ft.) which will replace the existing sign in main entry parking lot as well as a wall mounted full color Digital Reader board (7ft x 9.5 ft) that will be located on the front of main entrance facing the parking lot. These exciting new units will expand our abilities to highlight upcoming events, programs and activities and highlight special events like birthdays, anniversaries, and other special occasions. Look for future notifications on how to join in on the fun!

In our efforts to continue to expand, update, and re-energize our Fitness Center, we have purchased a new Life Fitness Integrity Treadmill which should also be arriving early January. This particular unit comes with the high-definition console and many other high technology features that users should really enjoy.

The District has received grant funding to do much needed renovations to the parking lot at the Annex facility through OregonBuys (State of Oregon). We have also submitted applications for funding to provide free swim lessons for special needs children through USA Swimming, to purchase kayaks and a Kayak trailer through Three Rivers Tribal Foundation to allow us to provide outdoor adventure programs connecting Teens with nature. We have also requested additional funding from Three Rivers Tribal Foundation to allow veterans free access to our pool and Fitness Center. We are hopeful that all of these will come through allowing us to continue to expand our program offerings and experiences for our community.
